

## John #66 – Jesus Continues to Reveal the Father – 12-07-23

### John 17:20-26

<sup>20</sup> “My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message,  
<sup>21</sup> that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so  
that the world may believe that you have sent me. <sup>22</sup> I have given them the glory that you gave me, that  
they may be one as we are one—<sup>23</sup> I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete  
unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.

<sup>24</sup> “Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you  
have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world.

<sup>25</sup> “Righteous Father, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have  
sent me. <sup>26</sup> I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love  
you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them.”

### 1 John 4:13-16

<sup>13</sup> This is how we know that we live in him and he in us: He has given us of his Spirit. <sup>14</sup> And we have seen  
and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world. <sup>15</sup> If anyone acknowledges that  
Jesus is the Son of God, God lives in them and they in God. <sup>16</sup> And so we know and rely on the love God  
has for us.

God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them.

### Exodus 24:15-18

<sup>15</sup> When Moses went up on the mountain, the cloud covered it, <sup>16</sup> and the glory of the Lord settled on  
Mount Sinai. For six days the cloud covered the mountain, and on the seventh day the Lord called to  
Moses from within the cloud. <sup>17</sup> To the Israelites the glory of the Lord looked like a consuming fire on top  
of the mountain. <sup>18</sup> Then Moses entered the cloud as he went on up the mountain. And he stayed on the  
mountain forty days and forty nights.

### Exodus 40:34-38

<sup>34</sup> Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle. <sup>35</sup> Moses  
could not enter the tent of meeting because the cloud had settled on it, and the glory of the Lord filled  
the tabernacle.

<sup>36</sup> In all the travels of the Israelites, whenever the cloud lifted from above the tabernacle, they would set  
out; <sup>37</sup> but if the cloud did not lift, they did not set out—until the day it lifted. <sup>38</sup> So the cloud of the Lord  
was over the tabernacle by day, and fire was in the cloud by night, in the sight of all the Israelites during  
all their travels.

### 1 Kings 8:6, 10-11

<sup>6</sup> The priests then brought the ark of the Lord’s covenant to its place in the inner sanctuary of the temple,  
the Most Holy Place, and put it beneath the wings of the cherubim.

<sup>10</sup> When the priests withdrew from the Holy Place, the cloud filled the temple of the Lord. <sup>11</sup> And the  
priests could not perform their service because of the cloud, for the glory of the Lord filled his temple.

**Ezekiel 10:18-19**

18 Then the glory of the Lord departed from over the threshold of the temple and stopped above the cherubim. 19 While I watched, the cherubim spread their wings and rose from the ground, and as they went, the wheels went with them. They stopped at the entrance of the east gate of the Lord's house, and the glory of the God of Israel was above them.

**Ezekiel 37:26-27**

I will make a covenant of peace with them; it will be an everlasting covenant. I will establish them and increase their numbers, and I will put my sanctuary among them forever. 27 My dwelling place will be with them; I will be their God, and they will be my people.

**John 1:14** - The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

**John 17:5** - And now, Father, glorify me in your presence with the glory I had with you before the world began.

**John 17:24** - "Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world.

**John 17:25-26**

<sup>25</sup> "Righteous Father, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have sent me. <sup>26</sup> I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them."

**John 3:19-20**

<sup>19</sup> This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. <sup>20</sup> Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed.

**John 15:4-8**

<sup>4</sup> Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.

<sup>5</sup> "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. <sup>6</sup> If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. <sup>7</sup> If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. <sup>8</sup> This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.
